

## ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

### MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

#### Special Programs (Rolling)

Faculty members may engage in special programs, delivered remotely, to include the Leadership Initiative Program and FRN Teach Share.

#### University Associate (Fall, Spring, Summer)

Institutions may annually nominate faculty members to participate in the University Associate program. Faculty members are provided with NYU Bobst Library physical access (no borrowing privileges).

#### Network Winter (January)

Institutions may annually nominate faculty members to participate in the Network Winter program. Faculty members are provided with course materials, lodging, and daily meals.

#### Network Summer (June)

Institutions may annually nominate faculty members to participate in the Network Summer program. Faculty members are provided with course materials, lodging, and daily meals.

#### Scholar Remote Fellowship (Fall and Spring)

Institutions may annually nominate faculty members to participate in the Scholar Remote program. Faculty members are provided with access to NYU libraries' e-resources.

#### Scholar-in-Residence (Fall, Spring, Summer)

Institutions may annually nominate faculty members to participate in the Scholar-in-Residence program. Faculty members are provided with access to NYU libraries' e-resources and borrowing privileges, a research consultant, and an option to audit an NYU course. Course audits are during fall and spring semesters only. Meals are provided during the summer session only. Accommodations may be provided to Scholars residing more than 50 miles from NYC. Housing accommodations are based on availability and not guaranteed.

#### Faculty Consultations (Rolling)

Faculty members are provided with confidential teaching consultations with an NYU instructional consultant. These are individual one-hour consultations.

#### National Symposia (November)

Faculty members are provided with free registration.

#### Student Exchange (Spring)

Up to two (2) undergraduate students, sophomores and juniors, from Network schools may be nominated annually to study at NYU during a spring semester taking courses at the College of Arts & Science; Gallatin School of Individualized Study; Steinhardt School of Culture, Education, and Human Development; Tandon School of Engineering; and Tisch School of the Arts. Tuition is paid to the home institution, and room and board are paid to NYU at the lowest posted rate comparing the fees of the host and home institution.
