The Faculty Resource Network

The sharing of resources among universities and colleges has become a hallmark of institutions striving to achieve new levels of academic excellence. Since 1984, New York University has sponsored the Faculty Resource Network, which now comprises 50 liberal arts institutions working closely with the University in a mutually rewarding partnership.

The central objective of the Faculty Resource Network is to offer faculty from member institutions opportunities to advance their curricular research and professional goals. Through its varied consortia programs, the Network provides a common forum for its members to share their academic pursuits, learn from one another, and develop new perspectives on the issues they confront in teaching and advancing scholarly concerns.

The Scholar Remote Fellowship Program

The Scholar Remote Fellowship affords Network faculty the opportunity to pursue research projects supported by the vast digital holdings of New York University's Division of Libraries. Scholars accepted into the program will be granted electronic access for up to one year to over one million e-books and 166,000 e-journals in NYU's online collections, connecting them to the scholarship of the world from their home or office. Scholars also receive access to additional online resources.

Selection for participation in the program is highly competitive. Applicants are required to submit applications detailing their intended scholarly activities to their institution's Faculty Resource Network Liaison Officer. Liaison Officers then forward applications to the Network office for final selection.

Prerequisites

Several prerequisites must be met for participation in the Network's Scholar Remote Fellowship program:

- The applicant must be a **full-time** faculty member at a **member institution** of the Faculty Resource Network. A list of Faculty Resource Network member institutions may be found on our website, <https://facultyresourcenetwork.org/membership/membership-institutions/>
- The proposed project must be sound and have scholarly merit.
- New York University must have the resources necessary to be of substantial benefit to the applicant's project goals.

To be considered for participation, applicants must submit to their campus Liaison Officer proposals that describe research or curricular development projects which would be advanced by participation in this program at New York University. These proposals should indicate ways in which the faculty member would benefit as a scholar and a teacher and ways in which the project would enhance the academic life of the home institution.

FOR THE FALL 2020 TERM: Completed applications must be in our office by **Tuesday, February 18, 2020.**

FOR THE SPRING 2021 TERM: Completed applications must be in our office by **Monday, September 28, 2020.**
